  - Dianne Clark Crafts back from medical leave one of the group's members did a needlework of a school bus and Charlie Brown is hanging at Lord Kelvin School.
  - Claudette Campbell mentioned the Century House Players will be on stage on 12th and 13th of May performing three plays.
  - Lynn Bittner-Jobson Blood Pressure clinic Detected very elevated blood pressure in 3 individuals.
  - Earl Christensen Both Whist and Court Whist continue to be very popular and this group could be outgrowing their Oak Room location.
  - Richard Nazarewich CH Walkers Attendance is largely weather driven.
     They get 14-15 people now which is up from last year. (was 23-27 before COVID)

 Wanda Madokoro - English Conversation - Getting more interest from students now but more teachers are needed. There were 6 teachers prior to COVID are now down to 3.
